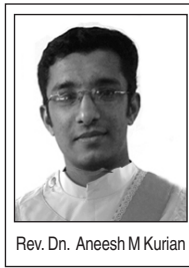

Back to the Banks of the Bharathapuzha

Dear Brothers and sisters in Christ.

This is my last letter to you as the vicar of the Immanuel Church in this tenure. As you know I am under orders of transfer. Many of you may remember the title of my first letter to the Immanuel family in the Newsletter of May 2004. It was entitled "From the banks of the Bharathapuzha to the Queen of Arabian Sea." In that letter I expressed my shortcomings as an almost inexperienced *achen* from the church in Shoranur (a town situated on the banks of Bharathapuzha) posted by Rt. Rev. Dr. George Isaac Thirumeni, to a big city Parish, the Immanuel Church, situated in Cochin, the Queen of the Arabian Sea. This comparison of river and ocean is right if the two churches are compared. But when I look back over my past five years in the Immanuel Church, I thank God for the way the Almighty has guided me, through the members of Immanuel Family, to extend my ministry to a level that I had not imagined. Every day that I spent in this church I experienced God's guidance in carrying out the Lord's ministry in different dimensions. My relationship with the Immanuel Church family has been so very good and my testimony is that I have not had any bitter experience in this church - I cannot recall even a single bad incident in this church. How great are the people of God in the Immanuel Family! All of you accepted me and my family as your very own. In every home in this parish, I have been treated not just as an *Achen*, but as a son, a brother, and even a grandson. All of you have shared your happiness and sorrows, problems and disasters and dealt with me and my family as if we are your own. I am not trying to flatter you, but I can state with firm conviction that I have learned from this congregation how much a parish can love its *Achen* in Christian love and fellowship.

All of you are ever ready to work for the Church as and when you are called up on. Many among you shared your thoughts on how the ministries of our church could be improved and many of these ideas were implemented. Whenever I put forward a suggestion, you supported it wholeheartedly. There was only one voice and one mind. This is very visible in all the projects and programmes that we organized and carried out together. If the oneness fails, we cannot complete even one programme or project satisfactorily.

Before I came here, I had no experience in any construction activity; it was not a priority in my ministry. But Immanuel Church taught me that even constructing something in stone and mortar can be a spiritual experience. The unfinished parsonage complex, with the ground floor completed, was the on-going project. Slowly, through the prayers of the people of God and the hard work of the pastorate committee together with me and my fellow *achens*, the land which belongs to the CSI in Mulavukad and Broadway has been transformed. Most of the buildings have been replaced with new structures and landscaping. God's guidance in demolishing and reconstructing the buildings was amazing - the completion of the three storied parsonage, demolition of the Bishop Moore Bhavan, construction of the Church and the parsonage at Mulavukad, construction of the Immanuel Church and the vault in the cemetery. In all these projects, the Spirit guided us to fulfill our tasks. The intervention of unknown people and the sources that God provides us in the time of extreme need is indeed marvellous. I had had many such experiences - all through these constructions- and I thank the Lord God Almighty for these.

The prayer life of the church enriched me greatly - especially worship services, area prayers, group prayers, whole-night prayers, chain prayers, birthday and wedding anniversary visits and prayers. I will never forget the prayers we conducted during the last days of the Immanuel Church construction when many members came to the chapel, prayed and read the entire Bible more than twice over. That was the inspiration for the speedy completion in a beautiful way.

All the coordinators and office bearers of all the fellowships, Sunday School Teachers of our church are wonderful persons with Christian commitment. I also thank the Choir Master, the Choir Secretary and both Junior and Senior Choir Members. I have special attachment to our senior organist Georgekuttychayan and I thank God for every one of them.

The love this congregation has for the Church is amazing. We have people from many different walks of life and both poor and rich. But they all contributed to the Church according to their ability. During these years one family contributed more than 52 Lakhs to the Church for various projects at the time of need. At the same time there are persons who brought their first month's full salary, without taking anything – not even a rupee - from it, for the activities of the Church. This is a congregation of well wishers. No one is interested in putting their names or announcing their names publicly for their contribution to be acknowledged and I praise God for the Christian giving of this congregation.

Another new experience for me was starting a Mission field. The activities in the Anakkulam High Range area and the Adimali Immanuel Home inspired me a lot. The care for the sick, the hungry, the poor and the needy are the different perspectives of the mission of the Immanuel family. Supporting missionaries, evangelical conventions and other such activities enriched me also along with the Immanuel family.

During our tenure here Amitha could complete the MA degree in Economics.

I was able to complete the M.Phil degree in Development Studies from MG University. Our family was blessed with an Immanuel Child – Arpitha (Kunju). During this period we lost Amitha's mother. In our happiness and our sorrow this congregation encouraged us and consoled us. I gratefully remember the well-wisher who provided us a new vehicle that enabled us to conduct our ministry comfortably. Thank you so much.

God has provided a team for every thing that I could do in this church. Without them nobody can do anything. I once again appreciate the teamwork.

I was privileged to work with my fellow ministers. Rev. Julie Bird, Mr. Adrian Bird, Rev. Sunder Jacob, Rev. Jiji Varghese, Mr. C.K. Shine, Mr. Samkutty Daniel, Mr. Lalji M Philip, Mr. V. M. Wilson, Rev. V. Rooban and Rev. Dn. Aneesh M Kurian. I have been amazed at their loyalty, commitment and readiness to work at any time. They all were available for whatever was required. It is such a blessing that we never had any disharmony among the ministers and their support has enabled me greatly to carry out our ministry for the Lord.

Last but not least I must acknowledge the support of the Pastorate Committee and members of the diocesan council. They are the heart of the body of the Immanuel family. They function harmoniously with one voice and one vision and have supported me throughout and to their very best ability. I express my sincere thanks to all of them. The Honorary Secretary, Mr. J. Oommen is a visionary and a very good organizer who gave his right hand to support my pastoral ministry. Mr. Varghese Jacob, Treasurer of the Pastorate Committee was effectively the finance controller for all my activities. I was able to learn many things from these leaders of the Church.

Our Church staff Mr. Anil Lucose, our sexton Shibu and his family, Jose and Chandichettan - were part of our family. They looked after the parsonage, our children and aged fathers in our absence.

Once again I return to the banks of Bharathapuzha, but to a different place - Codacal Thirur, in Malappuram district - and to a different ministry as the Director of the CSI Mission Hospital. I do not know how God will use us in the new place. But the last five years of my ministry in the Immanuel Church has given me a lot of exposure and wonderful experience, good friends and prayer partners. I am sure all the experience that I have had from the Immanuel Family will be a blessing for my future ministry. As a brother, father, son and a parish priest I request your valuable prayers.

On behalf of my wife Amitha, our children Ajay, Amala (Chinnu) and Arpitha (Kunju), I extend our sincere thanks and our gratitude to our ever remembered Immanuel Family. Thank you ... Thank you ever so much.

Rt. Rev. Dr. T. B. Benjamin Thirumeni

The first Indian and the third Bishop of this Diocese, the Rt. Rev. Dr.T. B. Benjamin, was called to his Eternal rest on Wednesday 25th March at Kottayam. The burial service was held at the CSI Cathedral, Kottayam on Friday. Thousands of laymen and hundreds of clergymen attended the funeral. The Most Rev. Dr. J. W. Gladstone, Moderator along with 12 other bishops conducted the funeral. The Most Rev. Dr. Chrisostem Marthoma and the Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Marthoma of Marthoma Church were present. Bishop Benjamin was to celebrate his 102nd birthday on 17th May. He was the longest lived of our bishops and remains the only bishop to have held that high office in a diocese for 17 and a half years and the one to whom the synod granted an extension of 5 years after retirement. Thirumeni was a well wisher of the CSI Immanuel Church. His son Mr. Oommen Benjamin and family

are members of the Immanuel Church. More than 50 members together with our all our Achens attended the funeral. Our choir sang with the Cathedral choir in their choir robes to lead the service. Kindly uphold kochamma and the family members of Thirumeni in your prayers. Diocesan level memorial service will be held at CSI Cathedral, Calicut on 14th April 2009 at 10.00 am. All are invited to attend this memorial service.

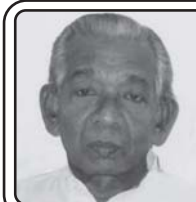
A meeting of the Almaya Suvisesha Sanghadana will be held at 10.00 a.m. on 18th April at our Church. All are welcome to attend this.

CMS Vellore and CMC Ludhiana

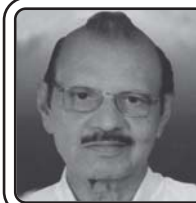
