Dearly beloved in Christ,

Dr. Cambel Morgen, a British Bible teacher, had four children and they all were Christian ministers. Somebody once asked Dr. Cambel's grand son, would you also like to become a pastor? "No, I'll look for some other job" he replied. This was perhaps a lament on what his parents experienced. God's work is sometimes overseen. Unlike many other works, this is basically a service to God and to His church and to the society. A person cannot be easily drawn in to this service. We see in the Bible, when God calls His chosen ones to lead His people, they were all reluctant to take up the task and the yoke of responsibility. But God always encourages, equips and empowers these leaders to shepherd and to flock them. Though people highly respect and esteem Christian ministry, why do not our parents choose to give his/her potential and talented children to the Lord's work? Instead we often find fault with the pastors and their ministry. We all require the best from the Lord. But what we would offer Him back? We always think that It is somebody else's duty and me and my family have nothing to do or have concern about it. The call of God is available to everyone. Are we positively responding to the call? If we neither go ourselves or send our children, can't we accept the one whom God sends among us to work in His vineyard?

For an ordinary worker, he/she has to please the master or manager, and not many people will indulge in his personal matters.  If he pays attention to the wealthy, he strengthens the aristocrat.
 If he uses too many illustrations, he neglects the Bible.

 If he preaches the truth, he is offensive.
 If he does not preach the truth, he is a hypocrite.
 If he fails to please every body he is hurting the church and ought to leave.

 If he drives a new car, he is setting his affection on earthly things.
 If he preaches all the time, people are tired of hearing.
 If he invites guest speakers, he is shirking his responsibility.

Let us thank God for the leadership of the church and let the spirit of God empower them to minister to the congregation more meaningfully and effectively. Books to the poor

This year we were able to provide books to the poor children of 175 families. Though the applicants were numerous we had to stick to the above number. Rev. Kurian Peter with a prayer inaugurated the distribution of notebooks and the recipients were glad and thankful to the congregation for the concern shown. We appreciate and thank all the contributors for this wonderful service to the society.

Diocesan Women's Conference

The Diocesan Women's Conference was held at our church from 20th to 23rd May 2010. Rt. Rev. Dr. K.P. Kuruvilla with an inaugural prayer hoisted the conference flag and Prof. Mercy Williams the honourable Mayor of Cochin City officially inaugurated the conference. In her inaugural address she said women play a crucial role in rebuilding broken relationships, both within families and in society. They play many sacred roles in society, including that of a housewife.

The conference's theme was 'Jesus Reconciles'. Ms. Williams exhorted the weak and downtrodden in society to believe in God's power and also in themselves, so that they grow in strength. *"Each deed must be for the glory of God's name."*

More and more women are coming forward to do risky ventures, she said, referring to women astronauts going on missions to outer space.





Women must ensure their safety and if need be get trained in self-defence.

The Bishop of the North Kerala Diocese, Rt. Rev. Dr. K P Kuruville said *“Reconciliation is central to Christianity. It might be difficult to achieve, but one must not give up. Reconciliation plays a major role in building lasting peace and also in erasing societal inequalities. The widening economic inequality and exploitation of people is behind most incidents of extremist violence. People must remember that God treats everyone equally. Christ gave up His life for the sake of reconciliation.”*

Even among women, it is tough to hear a united voice. Very often, women demean women. This must end, Rt. Rev. Kuruville said. Referring to the life of present-day Christians, he said that there is discrimination even within Christianity. *“The Holy Bible speaks of salvation for even non-Christians. But some Christians suffer from superiority complex and do not treat other religions on par.”*

Welcoming the gathering, Elizabeth Kuruville, the Fellowship’s president said that reconciliation becomes easy once God becomes central to our life. *“There is need to reconciliation within families, in churches and in society.”*

The others who spoke include Beena Sebastian, Chairperson of the Cultural Academy for Peace and Dr. Soumini Jayan, General Secretary, Womens Fellowship.

We placed on record our heartfelt thanks and appreciation to the Achens, Smitha Kochamma, Emimal Kochamma, Mrs. Molly Oommen, Mrs. Betsy Sunil, Dr. Soumini Jayan, the local and area women’s fellowship members, the young women of the youth fellowship. Our special thanks goes to Mr. Jayan Samuel, Glancy, Reetha, Shibu and others for their untiring efforts and co-operation which made this gathering a great blessing and a successful one.

General Election

The Diocesan general election to the pastorate committee and diocesan council will be held on 11th July, 2010 soon after the Malayalam service. We need 12 persons to the pastorate committee and 8 to the diocesan council. Women and the youth shall represent 3 persons each to the pastorate committee and 2 each to the diocesan council. As June 5th falls as the World Environment Day we as the church observe Sunday the 6th of June as Environment Sunday. We will be planting some saplings. Those who are interested to take a sapling home to plant in your plots are welcome. You can have one sapling per family. We will be distributing paper bags with a logo of ecological concern and biblical insight. This can be used to carry your bibles, song books, etc. to the church. Let the spirit of God regenerate the hidden powers of this mother earth and let the people rejoice in the providence and abundance of nature.

In enriching the family bonds and communion among families, the Family Care Fellowship plays a vital role. Visit to the Holy Land



By God's grace CSI Immanuel Church organized a holy land pilgrimage under the leadership of Rev. Kurian Peter from 12th to 20th May 2010. There were 30 members in the group. On the 1st day we landed in Amman and after the immigration formalities, we straightaway proceeded to visit Mount Nebo, where Moses was shown Canaan, the land of honey and milk, the presumed site of Moses' death and burial. We also could see the bronze serpent erected there. On day two we proceeded to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus and home of Mary and Joseph. We

visited the Basilica of the Annunciation built over the grotto where Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary to announce the birth of baby Jesus. We could see Joseph's workshop and then we visited Cana where Jesus performed His first miracle, converting water into wine at the wedding feast. On the third day we visited Mount Tabor, Capernaum, the church of the Multiplication of the five loaves and two fishes and the expressive church of the Beatitudes, where Jesus gave the Sermon on the



Mount. We had St. Peter's fish for lunch at a restaurant beside the Sea of Galilee. We also had an enjoyable ride in a replica of a Galilean fishing boat of that time on the Sea of Galilee. We stopped at St. Peter's house, where Jesus healed his mother-in-law. Then we went to Jordan River, the traditional Baptismal site. We saw the Mount of Temptation and Sycamore tree of Zachaeus.

On Saturday we walked along the Palm Sunday road to the Garden of Gethsamane. Then we visited the church of St. Peter of Gallicantu where Peter denied



Jesus three times before the cock crowed twice. On the Sabbath day at this Church, Rev. Kurien Peter celebrated Holy Communion Service in which all members of our team participated and it was a God-given opportunity for all of us to worship our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ in the Holy Land, which will remain indelible in our minds in the years to come.

We also visited the traditional House of High Priest Caiphas where Jesus was imprisoned. Then we proceeded to Bethlehem to visit the shepherd's field where the angel announced the birth of Jesus to them. We then visited the Church of Nativity, the birth place of Jesus and the Milk Grotto.

On Sunday we took the Via Dolorosa (Way of Grief), traditionally accepted as the last route trodden by Jesus. We followed 14 Stations of the Cross to Golgotha, where we experienced the suffering and passion of our Saviour. Further we entered the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea where our Lord's Body was buried after crucifixion. On the same day we also visited the tomb of Lazarus which was a divine experience of the miracle Jesus performed in raising Lazarus from death.



Then we went to see the last supper room, the tomb of King David and Bethany, the town of Mary and Martha. In the afternoon we proceeded to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on Earth which is 1305 ft below Sea level. We went to a private beach and we had the wonderful memorable opportunity to float in the salty buoyant water rich in minerals. In the evening we visited the famous Wailing Wall, where we could see people from different parts of the world coming with their grief and sorrow, crying and praying to God, touching their forehead on the wall, with fervent faith that God would answer their prayers.

On the sixth day we proceeded to Taba. On the way we viewed Qumran caves, the statue of Lot's wife and we had a panoramic view of the beautiful Red Sea. Then we reached Taba, finished the customs and immigration formalities at the Israel side and entered Egypt. The drive to Sinai was really wonderful since we were travelling in the midst of numerous mountains on both sides of the road. The deserted road surrounded by huge lofty mountains reminded us the words of the Psalmist, 'I look to the mountains; where will my help come from? My help will come from the Lord who made the Heaven and Earth.'

On the seventh day of our tour, we visited Saint Catherine's monastery set beneath the mountain where Moses is said to have received the Ten Commandments from God. This monastery has been one of the world's greatest centers of religious pilgrimage for over 15 centuries. Within it the sight of the burning bush was another heavenly experience for us. Then we proceeded to Egypt and we visited the Egyptian museum where the mummies are preserved. Then we had an exhilarating cruising on the river Nile in a magnificent ship where we met a host of tourists from different parts of the world and we enjoyed the sumptuous dinner in the ship itself. On the last day of our visit, we visited the famous pyramids of Egypt, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Sphinx, a shop where we were shown how paper is made from Papyrus and Old Cairo which is busy like Mumbai. That afternoon after lunch in a ship-restaurant, we went to Cairo airport and took the return flight.

The Holy Land pilgrimage was a spiritual enhancement for us. From our childhood we have learnt about the birth of Jesus Christ, his younger days and his ministry for 3 and a half years, the trials and tribulations He had to undergo, the way of the cross, the passion and sufferings, the crucifixion, death and the mighty resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Holy Land visit made us understand and experience these Biblical truths and facts and all the members in the group were ennobled and enriched spiritually by this holy sojourn. Rev. Kurian Peter



took the lead of this programme and every morning and evening, at the start and close of our journey, we had family prayers – singing hymns, saying psalms and praying together. The stay and accommodation were of high standards and we had no problems anywhere. This pilgrimage has promoted the expression of various talents of our members, the courage and ability in handling diverse situations, the sharing of knowledge by senior persons like Mr. John Mathew, Smitha Kochamma's father and the support, cooperation and dedication of the members, right from Kripa the youngest to the senior most, who worked as a team. We all helped each other in achieving the purpose and objectives we had set for this programme,

We thank God Almighty for His guidance, protection and abundant blessings on our trip to the Holy Land.
